Preserving and protecting those elements is what drives us. Our goal is to instill a conservation ethic in the people and places we serve to support sustainable communities rich with protected natural resources.




Lake Huron Forever

Lake Huron communities are ready to identify and implement nature-based solutions and robust citizen engagement in order to provide safe, accessible water and strong, vibrant communities



































Lake Huron Forever Pledge



- Reducing and improving the quality of stormwater runoff from within the city limits.
- Combat invasive species Invasive Species
- Reduce the use of toxic or otherwise harmful chemicals throughout City departments including fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, cleaners and disinfectants.
- Increase environmental education efforts targeted at the general public. Sharing information and stories with the Au Gres community is an essential aspect of this work.
