Thank you for your quick response to my email.

After I sent that email, I read a news article reporting the annual gross revenue from paid parking at the MNMC is estimated at just over \$399,000.

If you figure 50 weeks (holidays), 5 days a week, 9 hours a day, there will be 59 cars entering that lot every hour. If my numbers are correct, \$399,000. annual revenue is impossible.

The Town of Goderich should report contributions from the Province of Ontario to the MVMC, each and every year to the residents. In fact, a sign should be in the Medical Centre reporting the amounts.

Staff members in OMERS went from 64 in 2022 to 103 in 2023. That is a big increase in staff.

In the reserve funds set aside for specific purposes, one fund is for electricity distribution contingency. The amount is \$1,961,422 .

I think it started By-Law 101 of 2002, continued in By-Law 29 of 2012. The balance was \$1,690,275 in 2012, \$1,961,422 in 2023.

I can only find interest added to the fund each year.

Is this reserve fund being used? What am I missing?

Why are the town's financial statements not available online?

RE: Memorial Arena

The consulting fee of \$85,000. should be used toward the removal of the asbestos from the arena.

There was a DSS done by Wood Environment in April 2019, another DSS was done by Amec in 2013.

You do not have to do another DSS.

The asbestos has to be removed, whether you renovate or demolish.

If the building falls down when they remove the asbestos, the decision will be easier to make.
