## MENESETUNG BRIDGE REPAIRS

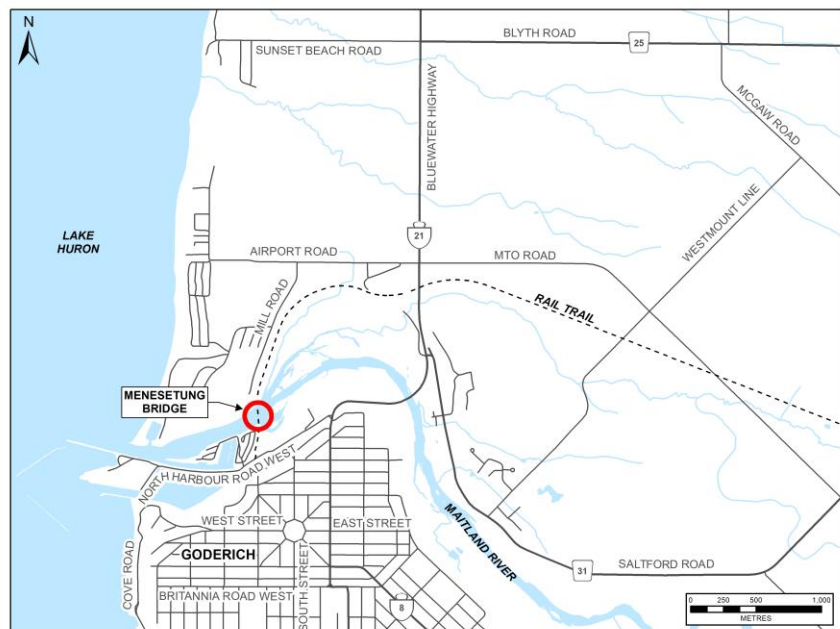

The Menesetung Bridge Association hereby gives notice that a submission has been added to the Common Project Search (online registry) pursuant to the *Canadian Navigable Waters Act* described herein and its description.

Pursuant to paragraphs 4.1 and 9.1 of the said Act,

The Menesetung Bridge Association has deposited with the Minister of Transport, on the on-line Common Project Search Registry (<http://cps.canada.ca/>) and under registry number 12074, a description of the following work:

The Menesetung Bridge Association is planning to repair the Menesetung Bridge, a 212m span girder pedestrian bridge spanning the Maitland River. The bridge is located 300m north of North Harbour Road West in Goderich, Ontario, as shown on the map. The bridge has a wooden deck and railings well above the water, as well as six piers and two abutments. The work includes concrete repairs to the abutments



and multiple piers. The repairs will be completed from a temporary floating barge or platform to access the piers. Small hand tools will be used to complete the repairs. Navigation under the structure will not be impacted during construction.
