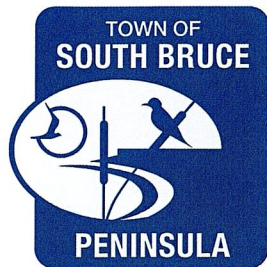

24. Notice of Motion – Mayor Kirkland – Support for Goderich Port Management Corporation

R-99-2026

It was **Moved** by J. Kirkland, **Seconded** by C. Hull and **Carried**

That the Goderich Port Management Corporation has filed an application to the Southwestern Ontario Development Fund for the Agri-Dome project at the Goderich Harbour;

And that The Agri-Dome project will benefit economic development and growth, reduce transportation costs of commodities, reduce truck traffic on local roads leading to improved safety for motorists, reduce maintenance costs of public infrastructure and reduce greenhouse gas emissions;

And that the County of Bruce has expressed their support for this application and has requested that lower tier municipalities also consider supporting the project.

Now therefore be it resolved that the Town of South Bruce Peninsula sees the importance of the Agri-Dome project to the Town of Goderich and to Ontario;

And further that the Town of South Bruce Peninsula supports the application for funding citing the importance of investing in this project which is of significant importance to the region's economic growth and the sustainability of its infrastructure.
