Hi Sean:

The new landfill methane regulations will not apply to Mid-Huron. The *text below* is an excerpt from the regulation that confirms applicability; although we only have volume information for landfilled wastes prior to site closure, there is no way the minimum tonnage threshold would have been met even with extremely well compacted wastes.

**Application**

**3 (1)** Subject to subsections (2) and (3), these Regulations apply to

- (a) any landfill in which any quantity of municipal solid waste was disposed of after January 1, 2010 and that has more than 450 000 tonnes of municipal solid waste in place; and
- (b) any landfill in which more than 20 000 tonnes of municipal solid waste was disposed of in 2025 or is disposed of in any subsequent calendar year and that has more than 200 000 tonnes of municipal solid waste in place.
