Hi Sean and Jessica:

In November 2025 we met with the Mid-Huron Landfill Board to discuss hydrogeological findings to date related to leachate generation at the site. As a result of the meeting and discussion, the hydrogeologist (Ian D. Wilson Associates) was asked to complete up to four additional monitoring wells at the southwest corner of the RDA in order to:

1. Further delineate sand and gravel deposits in the area, relative to the RDA bottom and perimeter drain, in order to better confirm flow paths for groundwater into the landfill which generates leachate.
2. Help support conceptual design of options to intercept that groundwater flow.

Weather and deep snow accumulation at the site have prohibited access for drilling of the monitoring wells this winter. At the moment, drilling is tentatively booked for March 2nd, with the hope that snowmelt is sufficient by that time. Timing could be potentially advanced or delayed, all depending on snow conditions.
